

## ONSITE SUNDAY SCHOOL GUIDELINES AT KMUPC:

- In person children and youth Sunday school (grades Preschool through 12<sup>th</sup> grade) begins Sunday October 18, 2020 from 9:45 AM- 10:45 AM.
- Everyone is asked to wear a mask when in the building. By wearing a mask: 1) you are protecting others from any germs you may have that you are unaware of; 2) you are providing peace of mind to those who are afraid of contracting the disease or passing it on to others; and 3) you are showing others that you care about them. Children under 2 are not expected to wear a mask. Children age 2 to 5 should wear a mask at the discretion of their parents.
- The church entrances are thoroughly sanitized and cleaned after the 8:30 service in preparation for Sunday school and the 11:00 service. Classrooms are cleaned during the week.
- A greeter will log your child's name and then take a one second temperature scan with an infrared forehead thermometer. Hand sanitizer will be used in each classroom. We will social distance as much as possible.
- Classrooms will not open until 9:35 AM. This allows the teachers to arrive and prepare the rooms.
  - Preschool, Kindergarten and 1<sup>st</sup> Graders will use the main "Nursery" room to the left of the bulletin board in the children's wing. Sandy Dickson and Lari Skowron will lead this group.
  - 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Graders will use the Room to the right of the bulletin board (known as the "craft" room). Renee Trunick will lead this group with weekly assistance from a willing/ caring parent.
  - Lower Middle School (grades 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>) will use the room next to the Sunday School Office. We welcome back Della and Vanessa Wozniak as teachers for this class.
  - Upper Middle School (grades 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>) and High School (9<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup>) will use the three rooms in the lower rear hallway across from Friendship Lounge. Jeannette Ditzenberger and Tina Ernst will lead this group.
- We ask that you explain to your child to refrain from hugging anyone not in your immediate family or social circle. Express your love/ affection for one another with words only.
- Only send in food if your child has food allergies. Children can bring a water bottle. Teachers will distribute individual drink or food on specific occasions.
- We are not using Sunday school envelopes for children's offerings at this time, but we ask that you bring a regular size box of cereal to help supply the food pantry for families in need.
